SENATE AMENDMENT " E " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 906,
L.D. 1250, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing a State-wide Open Deer
Season for the First Three Weeks in November."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the 11th and 12th
lines and inserting in place thereof the following: 'The 4th
Monday in October and continuing for 5 calendar weeks.'

Further amend said Amendment in the 18th line by striking out
the words and figures "October ~~14th~~ 23rd" and inserting in place
thereof the following words and figures '~~October-14th~~ the 3rd
Saturday in October'

Further amend said Amendment in the 4th line from the end by
striking out the words and figures "October ~~14th~~ 23rd" and inserting
in place thereof the following words and figures '~~October-14th~~ the
3rd Saturday in October'

Further amend said Amendment in the last line by striking out
the period and inserting in place thereof the following: ',except
that as it applies to the Northern Zone it shall become effective
January 1, 1972.'
