HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H. P. 906, L. D. 1250, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing a State-wide Open Deer Season for the First Three Weeks in November."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 1 the following new section:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, § 2353, amended. Section 2353 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end the following paragraph:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any resident of the State holding a regular hunting license may hunt deer for an additional 3 days, from the last Thursday in November to the Saturday following.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 2 and 3 to be sections 3 and 4.

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to give the working people of the State an extra weekend to hunt.
