SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 907, L. D. 1251, Bill,
"AN ACT Increasing Compensation for Members of the State Board of
Barbers."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the period in the title the
words 'and State Board of Hairdressers'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the
first line after the enacting clause the abbreviation and figure
'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting before the statement of
fact the following:


'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 32, § 1601, amended. The last paragraph
of section 1601 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended
to read as follows:

Each member of the board shall be allowed the sum of \$20-\$35
per day and their necessary expenses for actual attendance upon any
examination of candidates for registration and for any necessary
hearings and board meetings.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the per diem
compensation for the State Board of Hairdressers the same as the bill
does for the State Board of Barbers.
