## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Relating to Certificate of Registration Limited to Manicuring.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 1655, amended. The 3rd sentence of the first paragraph of section 1655 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Certificate of registration limited to manicuring only may be issued upon complying with such training and examination requirements as may be determined by the board and upon payment of the fees as provided by this chapter.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow the hairdressers board to establish standards for licensing manicurists without requiring them to have full training as hairdressers.
