**AN ACT Prohibiting Publication of Real Estate Tax Exemptions of Veterans
and Servicemen.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2203, sub-§ 3-A, additional. Section 2203 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new subsection 3-A to read as follows:

3-A. Tax exemptions for veterans and servicemen. Publication of exemptions received by veterans and servicemen pursuant to Title 36, section 653 shall be prohibited.

STATEMENT OF FACT

As certain municipalities publish the names of veterans lawfully entitled to exemption from real estate taxation, it is the intent of this legislation to prohibit such publication and the accompanying embarrassment.
