COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 927, L. D. 1281, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to the Payment of Dues to Grower Organizations  
by Handlers and Processors of Farm Products."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated  
"§1091." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§1091. Dues

· If a member of a cooperative agricultural marketing  
association shall make a written assignment of dues to such  
association, such dues shall be paid out of funds due or to  
become due to such member for any farm product produced or to be  
produced by such member, or for any services performed or to be  
performed by such member in the production of farm products.  
Pursuant to a collective marketing contract any person who accepts  
or receives such product or services under such contract from  
the member is bound by such assignment after receiving written  
notice from the association and from the member, and such person  
shall withhold the assigned dues from amounts payable by him to  
the member thereafter during period of such assessment.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include services in  
deducting membership dues.
