STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Salary Increases for Certain State Liquor Store Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Salary increase. All state liquor store employees who are employed on a regularly scheduled shift from 12 noon to 8 p.m. shall receive a 2-step increase under the present state pay plan.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Due to the fact that the employees affected by this bill do suffer personal inconvenience as their work day encompasses 2 meals daily and further deprives them of much normal family contact due to late closing, it is felt that this added compensation is justifiable.
