# STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Prohibiting Insurance Licenses for Banks and Savings and Loan Associations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 24-A, § 1514-A, additional. Title 24-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 132 of the public laws of 1969, is amended by adding a new section 1514-A to read as follows:

§ 1514-A. Prohibition as to banks and savings and loan associations

No license as an agent, broker or consultant shall be issued to a bank, a savings and loan association, a holding company or subsidiary of either of the foregoing or any officer, agent, representative or employee thereof.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would prevent banks, savings and loan associations and related parties from conducting the business of an insurance agent, broker or consultant.
