HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " S. P. 450, L. D. 1296, Bill, "AN ACT Permitting the Liquor Commission to Issue Liquor Licenses to Public Golf Courses."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 2 the following: 'Sec. 3. R. S., T. 28, §702, amended. The first sentence of section 702 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

No licensee for sale of liquor to be consumed on his licensed premises shall permit, on his licensed premises, any music, except radio or other mechanical device <u>including movies</u>, any dancing, <u>movies</u> or entertainment of any sort unless the licensee shall have first obtained from the commission a special amusement permit for which he shall pay to the commission a fee of \$10.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 3 to 5 to be sections 4 to 6.

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to permit movies to be shown by on-premise license**e**s.
