HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 450, L. D. 1296, Bill, "AN ACT Permitting the Liquor Commission to Issue Liquor Licenses to Public Golf Courses."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 4 the following:

'Sec. 5. R. S., T. 28, § 805, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 805 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 166 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Licensed clubs may sell liquor to nonmembers if they so desire.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering section 5 to be section 6.

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to place private golf courses and nonprofit organizations on the same business basis as public golf courses.
