SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 451, L. D. 1297, Bill,
"AN ACT Phasing out Log Driving in the Inland Waters of the
State."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end before the Statement
of Fact the following:

'3. Exception. This section shall not apply to waters
under the jurisdiction of the International Joint Commission
of the United States and Canada.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to avoid a conflicting
claim of jurisdiction over the St. Croix River, which is under
the jurisdiction of the International Joint Commission.
