

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 942, L. D. 1301, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Birch Point Village Corporation."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'<u>Emergency preamble</u>. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Town of West Bath pays over to the Birch Point Village Corporation 60% of all tax moneys collected each year; and

Whereas, since the town and the village corporation have agreed that this arrangement is no longer in the best interests of such town and the village corporation; and

Whereas, it is essential that the following legislation be operative as soon as possible to permit the village corporation to manage its own affairs and to assess and collect taxes for such purposes; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the

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Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is reflected in the emergency preamble.
