RESOLVE, to Reimburse Clarence Eldridge of Liberty for Loss of Sheep Killed by Dogs.

Clarence Eldridge; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Dog Tax Fund the sum of \$100 to be paid to Clarence Eldridge of Liberty, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for 5 sheep killed by dogs.
