HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 944, L. D. 1303, Bill,
"AN ACT to Clarify the Law Regulating the Alteration of Coastal
Wetlands."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 8

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last
sentence in section 10 before the Statement of Fact.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 9 and 10
to be 8 and 9

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to retain the limited
exemption of roads and bridges used in agricultural and
forestry operations as now provided in the law and to eliminate
the new prima facie provision proposed by the bill.
