**AN ACT to Increase Compensation of the Boxing Commission.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 8, § 101, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 101 of Title 8 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 14 of chapter 476 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**Each member of the commission, except the chairman, shall receive a salary of \$1,300 a year, and the chairman shall receive \$1,500 a year, and each member's reasonable expenses, including transportation, incurred in the performance of his duties.**

Sec. 2. **Appropriation.** There is appropriated to the Boxing Commission from the General Fund the sum of \$1,925 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to increase the salary of the chairman of the Boxing Commission \$500 and the other members of the commission \$300 each.
