COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 951, L. D. 1314, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Fixing Boundaries or Locations for Highway
Purposes."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the Statement
of Fact, the following:

'When any real estate is damaged by the use and control for highway
purposes of such land outside the existing improved portion and
within the limits of 1 1/2 rods on each side of the center of the
traveled portion, they shall award damages to the owner as provided
in section 3005.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make this regulation uniform
and constitutional.
