SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 968, L.D. 1328, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Home Rule Procedure."

Amend said Bill by striking out at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure "Sec. 1."

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2.
