STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Repeal the Birch Point Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1917, c. 108, repealed. Chapter 108 of the private and special laws of 1917 is repealed.
- Sec. 2. Rights of the Birch Point Village Corporation vested in the Town of West Bath. Upon this Act taking effect, all real and personal property, or any interest therein, then owned by the Birch Point Village Corporation, together with all accounts receivable, choses in action, and all other rights and benefits that may be either then due and payable to, or would accrue to, or for the benefit of said Birch Point Village Corporation but for this Act, shall be and become the property of the Town of West Bath; said town being hereby vested with all rights and powers of holding, disposing of or enforcing such rights so acquired.
- Sec. 3. Contracts to be assumed by the Town of West Bath. Upon this Act taking effect, all valid contracts, obligations and liabilities of said Birch Point Village Corporation shall be assumed and executed by the Town of West Bath.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this Act to prevent a portion of real estate taxes from being returned to this Corporation, therefore the Corporation is being repealed.
