AN ACT Relating to Election of Officers of Hospital Administrative
District No. 3 in Aroostook and Penobscot Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1969, c. 68, § 2, amended. The 5th paragraph of section 2 of chapter 68 of the private and special laws of 1969 is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Each year the board of directors shall elect one member of the board to serve as president, a treasurer and secretary, neither of whom need be a director. Upon appointment of a hospital administrator, he will serve as secretary *ex officio* of the board.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that officers of Hospital Administrative District No. 3 do not have to be members of the board of directors.
