COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 971, L. D. 1331, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Water Quality Standards."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in the 9th and 10th lines (9th in L.D.)  
by striking out the underlined words and punctuation "or of  
heated effluent,"

Further amend said Bill in section 2 in the 9th and 10th  
lines (8th in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words and  
punctuation "or of heated effluent,"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the language  
referring to heated effluent since the Environmental Improvement  
Commission already has power to determine acceptable levels of  
heated effluent.
