COMMITTEE AMENDMENT 'A' to H. P. 976, L. D. 1338, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Weight Tolerances of Vehicles Loaded with
Refrigerated Products."

Amend said Bill in the 9th line (8th in L.D.) after the
amending clause by striking out "entirely with ~~any~~" and inserting
in place thereof 'with ~~any~~ a majority of'

Further amend said Bill in the 10th line (9th in L.D.)
after the amending clause by inserting after the word "equipment"
the underlined words and punctuation 'and on such vehicles when
inspected by the Maine State Police, the number of the seal
shall be recorded and the number of the new seal shall be recorded
by the Maine State Police'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to have the bill apply to
vehicles loaded with a majority of refrigerated products and
provide for recording of the seals on the vehicles.
