RESOLVE, Providing Funds for Repair of Certain Road in Town of Glenburn, Penobscot County.

Repair of road in Town of Glenburn, Penobscot County. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund to the Town of Glenburn, Penobscot County, the sum of \$5,000 to aid in repairing town road No. 50, Lake View Road, so called, beginning at the town building and extending about one mile to the junction of Route 221.

STATEMENT OF FACT

There are many roads in the small town of Glenburn and the town has expended about \$20,000 in repairing roads the past 2 years. The purpose of this bill is to aid the town in its financial difficulty in keeping its roads in repair.
