COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to H. P. 978, L. D. 1340, Resolve, Designating a Certain Road in Northeastern Maine as William F. McDevitt Road.

Amend said Resolve in the Title by striking out the name "William" and inserting in place thereof the name 'John'

Further amend said Resolve in the first line (same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined name "William" and inserting in place thereof the underlined name 'John'

Further amend said Resolve in the 4th line (3rd line in L.D.) by striking out the name "William" and inserting in place thereof the name 'John'

Further amend said Resolve in the 5th line (4th line in L.D.) by striking out the name "William" and inserting in place thereof the name 'John'

Further amend said Resolve by adding at the end before the Statement of Fact the following sentence:

'Suitable signs designating the said John F. McDevitt Road may be erected and maintained at no expense to the State and subject to the approval of the State Highway Commission.'
