SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 979, L.D. 1341, Bill, "AN ACT Eliminating Certain Organizations as Participating Local Districts under State Retirement System."

Amend said Bill in the 11th line (9th line in L.D.) by inserting after the striken out word "Association" the underlined words 'and employees of corporations designated as instrumentalities of municipalities'

Further amend said Bill in the 19th line (15th line in L.D.) by striking out the words and punctuation "authority, or" and inserting in place thereof the word and punctuation 'authority,'

Further amend said Bill in the 24th line (20th line in L.D.) by inserting before the word "approve" the underlined words

'or the executive committee of a corporation designated as an instrumentality of municipalities'

Further amend said Bill in the 33rd and 34th lines (28th line in L.D.) by striking out the words" 70r Maine National Guard" and inserting in place thereof ', Maine National Guard and corporations designated as instrumentalities of municipalities'

Further amend said Bill in the 39th line (33rd line in L.D.) by striking out the punctuation and word " τ or" and inserting in place thereof a comma

Further amend said Bill in the 42nd line (35th line in L.D.) by inserting after the striken out word and punctuation

"Association," the underlined words 'and corporations designated as instrumentalities of municipalities'
