IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT to Provide Funds for Additional State Office Space at Augusta.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$3,450,000, and the Bureau of Public Improvements is authorized and empowered, with the advice and consent of the Governor and Council, to expend said funds for the purpose of constructing and equipping additional state office facilities in Augusta in accordance with the capitol complex master plan.

Sec. 2. Policy matters. It is the intent of the Legislature that the Bureau of Public Improvements shall so perform its duties as to advise the Governor and Council on broad policy matters such as, but not necessarily limited to, time of construction, general type of facility, choice of location and determination of what departments of state government shall be located in the new facility.

Sec. 3. Appropriation shall not lapse. The appropriation provided by this Act shall not lapse but shall remain in a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide \$3,450,000 for an additional state office building.
