IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Androscoggin County: County commissioners, \$\\$3,000 \$3,400; chairman, \$\\$3,600 \$4,000; clerk of courts, \$\\$8,600, \$9,850; county attorney, \$8,500; first assistant county attorney, \$6,000; second assistant county attorney, \$6,000; county treasurer, \$6,050 \$7,300; sheriff, \$\\$8,000 \$9,250; register of deeds, \$6,800 \$8,050; judge of probate, \$6,000 \$7,250; register of probate, \$6,200 \$7,450.
