AN ACT Relating to Duty of State Board of Education
Concerning Interscholastic Activities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 60, additional. Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 60 to read as follows:

§ 60. Interscholastic activities

The State Board of Education shall have authority to control and supervise all interscholastic activities in public schools. The board shall promulgate rules and regulations as may be required for maximum benefits to students. In carrying out the intent of this section, the board may contract with private agencies. In its conduct and supervision of interscholastic activities the board is authorized to require financial reports and to disseminate such information.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The proposed Act will provide the State Board of Education with the same responsibility for interscholastic activities as exists for all other aspects of public school programs.
