**AN ACT Relating to Guides When Using Canoes at Summer Camps.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 12, § 2055, additional.** Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2055 to read as follows:

**§ 2055. Canoes**

**Any person or director in charge of a summer camp for boys and girls located in this State shall provide at least one qualified guide over 16 years of age for every 10 campers when canoeing on a river or stream, except that if there are less than 10 campers 2 such qualified guides shall be provided.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this bill to provide for the safety of boys and girls while using canoes on rivers and streams.
