HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 994, L. D. 1356, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Compensation for Minors Delivering Newspaper Supplements."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 26, §772-A, additional. Title 26 of the Revised
Statutes is amended by adding a new section 772-A to read as
follows:

§772-A. Minors delivering newspapers

No person, firm or corporation or their agent shall employ
any person under 18 years of age for the purpose of delivering
newspapers containing supplements or inserts unless such minor
persons are compensated 1¢ per supplement above their normal rate.
For purposes of this section a "supplement" or "insert" shall be
defined as one or more sheets of printed matter upon which is
printed advertising material only and which is not an integral part
of the newspaper.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to locate the bill in the
proper section of the Revised Statutes and to further define the
terms "supplement" and "insert."
