HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 996, L. D. 1358, Bill, "AN ACT Restricting Use of Certain Campsites."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§ 2256. Campsite restrictions

No person shall place any trailer camper, shelter, tent or shall camp on any lands in this State other than public campgrounds without permission from the landowner.

Any municipal, county or state law enforcement officer shall be authorized to enforce this section.

This section shall not apply to the unorganized territory of the State.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate unnecessary words from the bill and to exempt the unorganized territory of the State from the bill.
