AN ACT Restricting Use of Certain Campsites.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2256, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2256 to read as follows:

§ 2256. Campsite restrictions

No person shall place any trailer camper, shelter or tent on any lands in this State other than public or private compgrounds without permission from the landowner.

Any municipal, county or state law enforcement officer, fireman or warden shall be authorized to enforce this section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this Act to prohibit the use of lands for campsites without permission of the landowner.
