SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 496, L. D. 1372, Bill, "AN
ACT Relating to the Laws of the Maine Industrial Building Authority."


Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last paragraph of
section 6 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The authority shall have the power at all reasonable times
and places to make an examination of the books and records of the
mortgagee, lessee, tenant or assignee during the duration of the
mortgage.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to repeal and replace
section 6 because it was felt that section 6 would unduly restrict
the guarantying authority of the Maine Industrial Building
Authority.
