STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Providing Funds for Wildlife Upland at Pine Point, Scarborough.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game the sum of \$2,000 to match local and federal funds for the preservation, expansion and conservation of the natural environment, including wildlife, at the wildlife upland at Pine Point, Scarborough.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This site will be designated as a refuge and historical site. Local residents are interested in promoting for financial assistance and voluntary aid for this purpose.
