SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to S. P. 489, L. D. 1381, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Temporary Loans by the State."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting  
in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, §150, amended. The first sentence  
of section 150 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed  
and replaced by chapter 417 of the public laws of 1967, is amended  
to read as follows:


The Treasurer of State, with the approval of the Governor and Council,  
may negotiate a temporary loan or loans in anticipation of the  
issuance of bonds authorized but not yet issued, ~~as provided by the  
Constitution of Maine, Article IX, section 14.~~
