COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1008, L. D. 1387, Bill,
"AN ACT Appropriating Moneys to Supplement Loans by Maine School
Building Authority."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following new Title:
'AN ACT Relating to Nonlapsing Funds for Maine School Building Authority.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'P. & S. L., 1969, c. 242, amended. Chapter 242 of the private and special laws of 1969 is amended by inserting after the first sentence the following sentence:

Any balance remaining at June 30, 1971 shall not lapse but shall carry forward to June 30, 1973 to be expended for the same purposes.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make the funds provided in chapter 242 of the private and special laws of 1969 to be nonlapsing until June 30, 1973.
