IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Appropriating Moneys to Supplement Loans by Maine School Building Authority.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Maine School Building Authority; appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$50,000 to the Maine School Building Authority, for the purpose of providing grants to school administrative units to supplement lease-rental agreements for construction of needed classroom facilities. This appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1973. The breakdown shall be as follows:
