**AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Provide for Night Pay
Differentials for State Employees.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriations for night pay differentials for state employees. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$109,200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972 and the sum of \$218,400 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973 for the purpose of placing into effect, as of the first pay period in January, 1972, a 10¢ per hour increase for the 2nd shift of 3 p.m. to 11 p.m. and 15¢ per hour increase for the 3rd shift of 11:30 p.m. to 7:30 a.m. under the State Personnel Board's Compensation Plan for classified positions, such pay differentials for those who for the year or 90 days minimum are regularly employed and regularly scheduled for night shifts.

Said pay differentials shall be applied at the direction of the State Personnel Board, with the right of appeal to the State Employees' Appeals Board, by the employee or his representative, or both.

Said same provisions and standards shall be applied to those employees who are employed by departments which are supported wholly, or in part, by the General Highway Fund, special revenue or other funds.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of the 105th Legislature that night coverage shall be maintained adequately, wherever needed. It is the further intent that the provisions of this bill be applied to "Highway Night Patrol" in winter maintenance work and radio dispatchers.
