COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1012, L. D. 1391, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Funeral Expenses of Recipients of Public Assistance."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "§3409." of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:
'§3409. Funeral expenses

On the death of an active recipient of aid to the aged, blind or disabled, reasonable funeral expenses not exceeding \$150 \$200 shall be paid by the State if the estate of the deceased is insufficient to pay the same.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare the sum of \$40,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to have recipients of public assistance receive reasonable funeral expenses not to exceed \$200 and to change the appropriation of the bill from \$60,000 to \$40,000.
