HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to H. P. 1019, L. D. 1398, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Use of Hypodermic Syringes."

Amend said Bill in the 15th line (12th line in L. D.) by inserting after the underlined word "persons" the underlined words ', employees of scientific research laboratories, employees of an agency or organization duly authorized by the Maine Board of Commissioners of the Profession of Pharmacy'

Further amend said Bill in the 18th line (15th line in L. D.) by striking out the underlined words "subcutaneous injection" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'parenteral administration'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the first paragraph of that part designated "§2362-A." the following:

'This section shall not apply to such a syringe, needle or instrument for use on farm animals and poultry.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to also exempt from this law employees of an agency duly authorized by the Pharmacy Board in this State and the use of hypodermic syringes on cattle and poultry and to clarify wording in the original bill.
