# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Concerning Minimum Salaries for Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 1901, amended. The first paragraph of section 1901 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 462 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Each administrative unit operating public schools within the State shall employ only certified teachers and, after July 1, 1972, shall pay such teachers, except substitute teachers as defined by the commissioner, the minimum salaries as follows:
