**AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Substitute Teachers
and Adjusting State Subsidy to an Administrative Unit.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 1901, repealed and replaced. Section 1901 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended and as repealed and replaced by chapter 462 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§ 1901. Salaries for substitute teachers

Substitute teachers with 4 years of study beyond the high school and with a bachelor's degree and in possession of a standard teachers' certificate and substitute teachers who have retired after a minimum of 15 years teaching shall be compensated at the rate of not less than \$20 for each day of service.

After providing an opportunity for a hearing, the state board, on recommendation of the commissioner, may adjust the state subsidy to an administrative unit when, in the opinion of the board, the expenditures for education in such unit show evidence of manipulation to gain an unfair advantage or are adjudged excessive.
