SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 518, L. D. 1403, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Allow Electric Utilities to Participate in the  
Construction of Certain Utility Facilities."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 2308." by  
striking out in the 4th line of subsection 3 (3rd line in L.D.)  
the underlined words and punctuation 'distribution lines,'


Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 2309.:"  
by adding at the end before the period the following:

'and provided that section 171, notwithstanding the last sentence  
of subsection 1 thereof, shall be applicable to any domestic  
electric utility acquiring and operating utility facilities  
outside this State'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require Public Utility  
Commission approval for issuing of securities by New England  
electric utilities for construction outside of the State.
