SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1217, L. D. 1408, Bill, "AN ACT Making Additional Appropriations for the Expenditures of State Government and for Other Purposes for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1971."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last line before "Section 2" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'INSURANCE ADVISORY BOARD

Fire Insurance

Unallocated.....	165,000
Provides funds to reimburse the Contingent Account for the transfer made by Council Order to pay extraordinary premiums.	


TOTAL - Section 1..... \$998,600'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the next to the last sentence of "Section 2" and inserting in place thereof the following

'Amounting to \$2,123,600 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971.'
