HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 521, L. D. 1419, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Retirement Allowance for Former Governors."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General
Fund the sum of \$17,500 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The
breakdown shall be as follows:
