HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1027, L. D. 1422, Bill,
"AN ACT Revising the Implied Consent Law for Operators of Motor
Vehicles."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 1312." in
subsection 10 by striking out all of paragraph C and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'C. Every person operating a motor vehicle which has been
involved in an accident shall, at his request, submit to
a breath test to be administered by the police officer or
a blood test to be administered by a physician of the
person's own choosing.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit the person involved
in an accident to choose between a breath or a blood test.
