HOUSE AMENDMENT " F " to H. P. 1027, L. D. 1422, Bill,
"AN ACT Revising the Implied Consent Law for Operators of Motor
Vehicles."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 1312." by inserting
at the end of the 2nd paragraph the following sentence: 'At
his request he may have a test of his blood administered by a
physician of his choice, if reasonably available.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow the accused person
to have a test of his blood by a physician of his own choosing if
such physician is reasonably available.
