STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

RESOLVE to Reimburse Donald H. Young of Portland for Damage to Property by Escapee from Boys Training Center.

Donald H. Young; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$49 to be paid to Donald H. Young of Portland, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for destruction of property by an escapee from the Boys Training Center.

STATEMENT OF FACT

On Sunday, January 3, 1971, the residence of Mr. Donald H. Young of 37 Cobb Avenue, Portland, Maine was damaged by an escapee from the Boys Training Center. Said escapee attempted to gain admittance to the house by breaking side windows. This action resulted in considerable damage to the house. Mr. Young obtained the following estimates of cost for repair of the damage done: Damage to windows, \$31; damage to antique furniture and plants, \$18. Total estimated cost of repairs, \$49.
