## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to H.P. 1034, L.D. 1425, Bill, "AN ACT Clarifying the Statute Relating to Realty Subdivisions."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out all of that part designated "<u>§4801-A.</u>" and inserting in place thereof the following:

## '§4801-A. Single family residential; smaller lots

A lot containing less than 20,000 square feet may be used for single family residential purposes on the basis of percolation tests, soil type, soil observation holes made in a representative manner, and recommendations by a registered engineer.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to eliminate the Department of Health and Welfare and leaving to the local zoning board the administration of the bill.
