SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1034, L. D. 1425, Bill,
"AN ACT Clarifying the Statute Relating to Realty Subdivisions."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by adding at the end of that
part designated "§ 4801-A." the following new paragraph:

~~Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the first
paragraph of section 4801 as it relates to the minimum frontage
of a lot abutting on a public road may be waived by the
Department of Health and Welfare.~~
