STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Retirement Contributions by State Police and Wardens of the Departments of Inland Fisheries and Game and Sea and Shore Fisheries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 1095, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 1095 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 445 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

Anything to the contrary notwithstanding each member of the State Police, including the chief thereof, who became a member of that department subsequent to July 9, 1943, shall, beginning with the first full week after September 21, 1963 the effective date of this Act, make a 71/2% 5% contribution of earnable compensation to the retirement system as long as he is employed.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 5, § 1095, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 1095 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 445 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

Anything to the contrary notwithstanding, each warden in the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game and each warden in the Department of Sea and Shore Fisheries shall, beginning the first full week after the effective date of this Act, make a 7½% 5% contribution of earnable compensation to the retirement system as long as he is employed as a warden.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the State Retirement System from the General Fund the sum of \$32,923 and from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$62,701 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to bring the contribution made by the State Police and wardens of the Departments of Inland Fisheries and Game and Sea and Shore Fisheries into conformance with other contributions. The annual cost from the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game funds for the cost for the department's wardens will be \$19,848.
